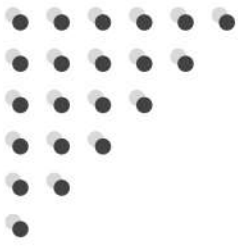

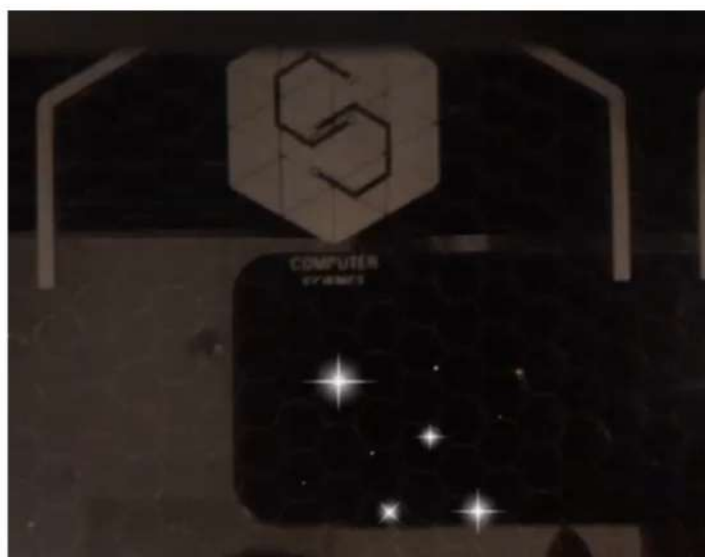
SECURITY EVENT



The event included an awareness lecture about cyber security and an exhibition for the club members projects on Monday 26-March-2018.

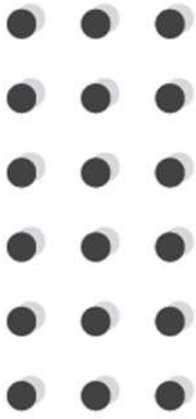
This event aimed to promote awareness about cyber security and information security risks.

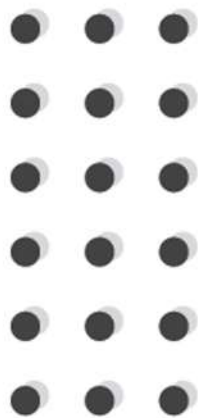

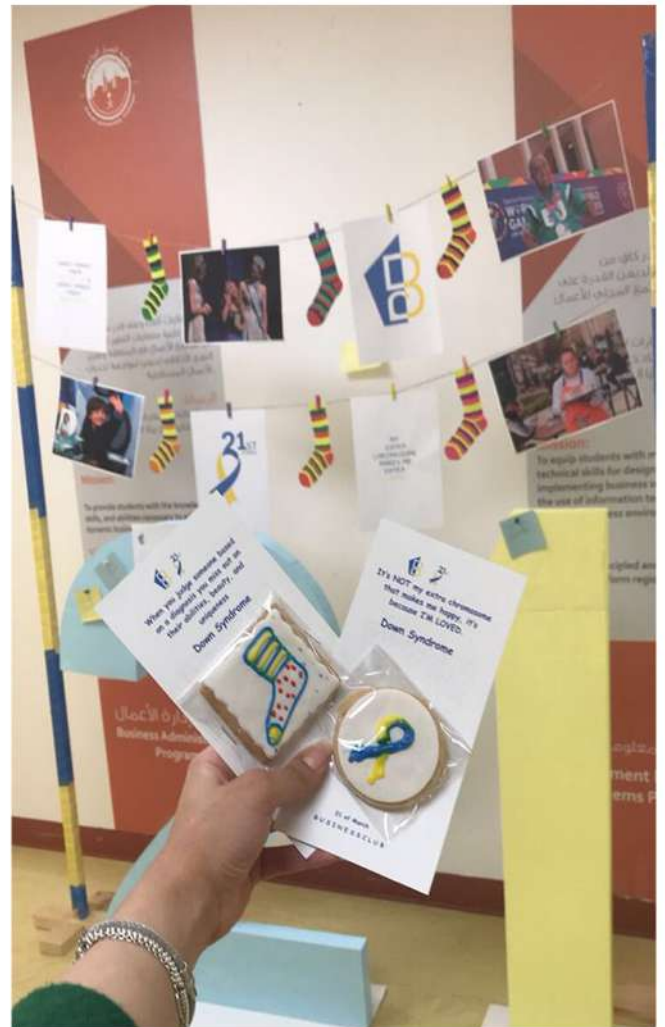
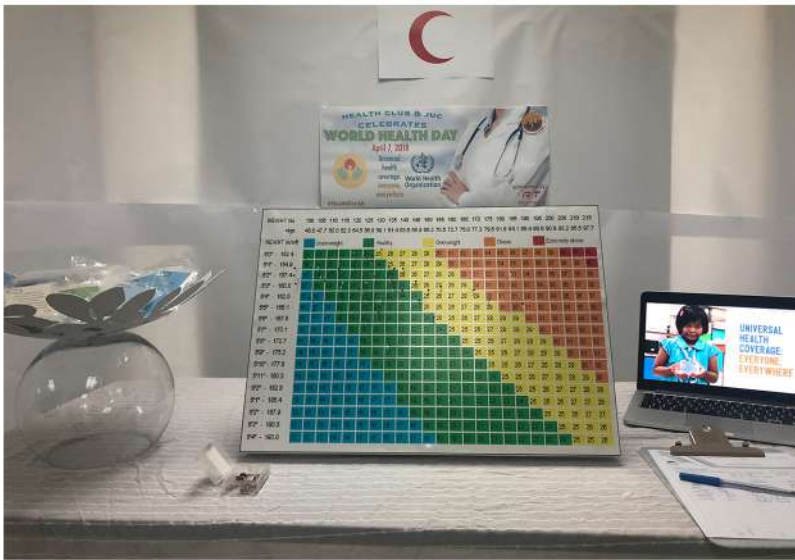


Religious Club Organized a Lecture Titled “In Between”

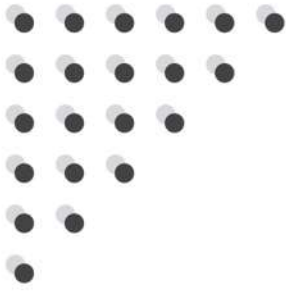
“Don’t Try It” Exhibition

The program included an awareness exhibition entitled “Do not Try It”, where awareness banners, manuals, sample bag of drugs, and prizes were presented.

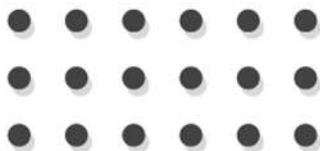

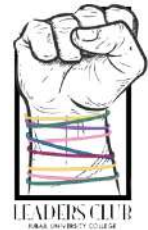


A gallery was aligned with the program where a mural representing passion was demonstrated to the audience, along with that public Arab figures were presented for inspiration.

The event included several recreational activities and competitions for the attendance.

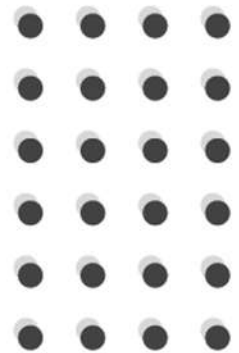
The activity was appreciated by the college staff and students.

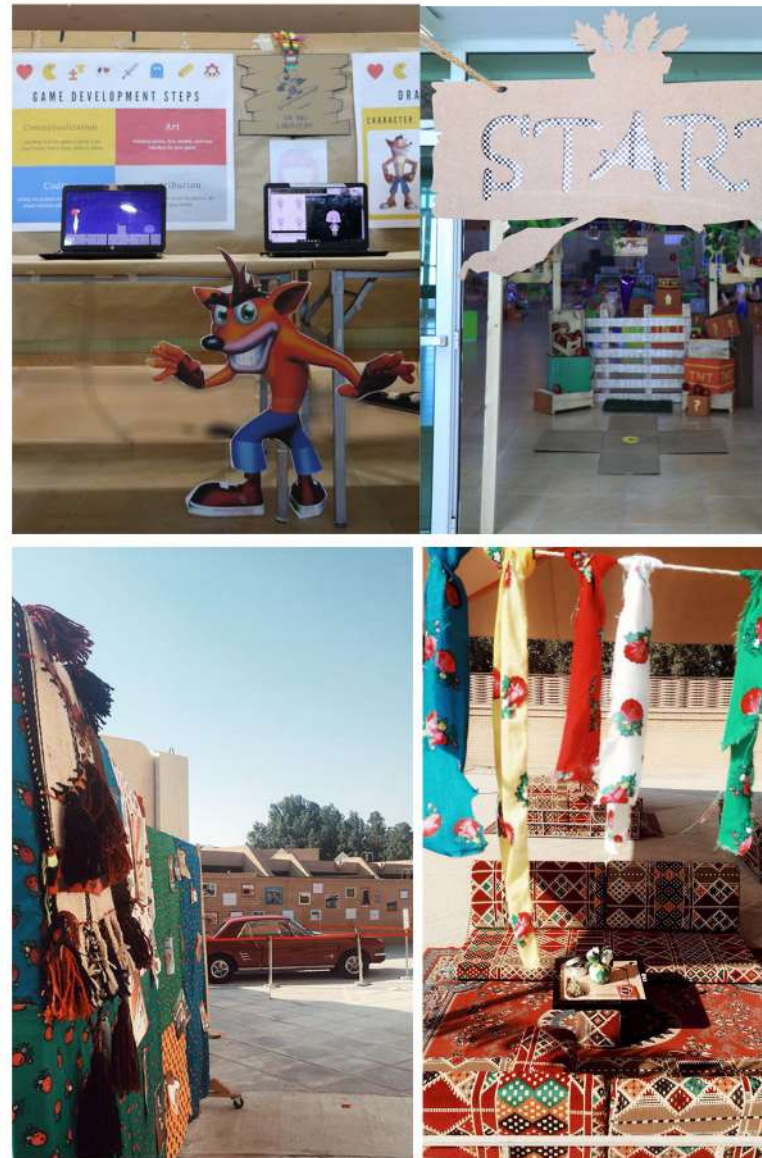

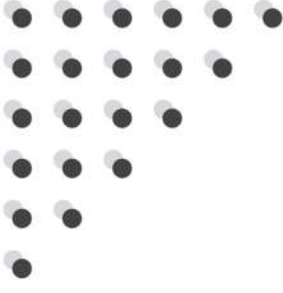
